

The National Day to Prevent Teen Pregnancy

Audio PSA Scripts

The 8th annual National Day to Prevent Teen Pregnancy will take place on May 6, 2009. The purpose of the National Day is to focus the attention of teens on the importance of avoiding teen pregnancy and other serious consequences of sex. On the National Day, teens nationwide are asked to take short, online quiz at *StayTeen.org* that asks them to reflect on the best course of action in a number of tough sexual situations.

These 15- and 30 second audio public service announcement (PSAs) scripts were created to help you promote National Day to Prevent Teen Pregnancy in your community. Feel free to record these PSAs as scripted or personalize them for your organization.

SCRIPT #1

EVERYBODY'S DOING IT

Length: 15 seconds

Audience: All teens

Guy/Girl 1: Everybody's doing it.

Guy/Girl 2: I'm going to.

Guy/Girl 3: Me too. I can't wait.

Narrator: You should try it, too.

SCRIPT #2

LYING

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: All teens

Guy/Girl 1: I've done it.

Guy/Girl 2: So have I.

Guy/Girl 3: Me, too.

Guy/Girl 4: Yeah, I've done it.

Narrator: Think everyone's doing it? Some are, some aren't and some are lying. Less than half of high-school aged teens are having sex. Not having sex is the only sure way to prevent teen pregnancy.

SCRIPT #3

MYTHS

Length: 15 seconds

Audience: All teens

Guy/Girl 1: I've heard that you can't get pregnant the first time, right?

Guy/Girl 2: Wrong. You can get pregnant the first time – and every time – you have sex.

Narrator: There are a lot of myths and half-truths out there about sex. How will you know what's real and what isn't when you make your decision about sex?

SCRIPT #4

THEY DIDN'T DO IT ALONE

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Teen girls

Guy/Girl 1: Last year, nearly seven hundred and fifty thousand teens got pregnant – and they didn't do it alone.

Chances are, they're alone now.

8 out of 10 teen dads don't marry their babies' mothers.

Narrator: If you think having sex will help keep him, and a baby will make him stay, you're wrong.

SCRIPT #5

WAYS TO SAY NO

Length: 15 seconds

Audience: All teens

Girl/Guy 1: Even with all the ways to say no.....

Girl/Guy 2: I not to ready to take care of a baby.

Girl/Guy 3: I could get an STD.

Girl/Guy 4: I'm too young.

Girl/Guy 5: I don't love you.

Girl/Guy 1: ...Why did I say yes?

Narrator: 2 out of 3 teens who've had sex wish they had waited longer. What will you do in the moment?

SCRIPT #6

PARENTS – START YOUNG

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Parents of teens

Girl/Guy: Mom, Dad – if you're not talking to me about sex because you think I'm too young, think again.

The truth is, you're the only one who's not talking to me about it.

Narrator: Don't wait for the perfect moment – they're not. 1 in 7 teens has had sex by age 15. Talk with your teens about sex, love and values. Now. They want to know what you think, even if they don't act like it.

SCRIPT #7

PARENTS - YOU'RE #1

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Parents of teen girls

Girl 1: Guess who teens say is their most important influence when it comes to sex?

Girl 2: Our parents.

Girl 1: Listen up - Teens want to know what you think, even if they don't act like it.

Narrator: Talk with your teens about sex, love and values. One out of every three girls get pregnant at least once by age 20 – make sure your daughter isn't one of them.

SCRIPT #8

PARENTS - START TALKING

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Parents of teen girls

Girl/Guy 1: Every morning when I get on the bus, the couple in front of me is making out.

Girl/Guy 2: At school, all my friends talk about is who is hooking up with who.

Girl/Guy 3: When I get home, all I see on TV is sex, sex, sex.

Girl/Guy 4: Mom...Dad...I hear about sex all the time. Why don't I hear about it from you?

Narrator: Parents, your kids want to hear from you about the consequences of sex. Encourage them to take the National Day to Prevent Teen Pregnancy quiz at StayTeen.org and use it to start an important conversation today.

SCRIPT #9

MAMI, PAPI

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Parents of teens

- Girl 1:** Mami, Papi – Me dicen lo que tengo que hacer con respecto a la escuela, mis amigos, y todas las otras cosas – porque nunca me hablan sobre el sexo?
- Girl 2:** Tres de cada cinco adolescentes Latinas quedan embarazadas, por lo menos, una vez, antes de los 20 años. Hablanos. Queremos saber lo que piensan.

SCRIPT #10

NO LO HICIERON SOLAS

Length: 30 seconds

Audience: Teen girls

Girl 1: El año pasado, casi un millón de adolescentes se quedaron embarazadas - y no lo hicieron solas.

Pero la realidad es que la mayoría, ahora están solas.

Eso es porque 8 de cada 10 padres adolescentes no se casan con las madres de sus bebés.

Guy 1: Si piensas que tener sexo con él y tener su bebé va hacer que él se quede contigo, estás equivocada.
