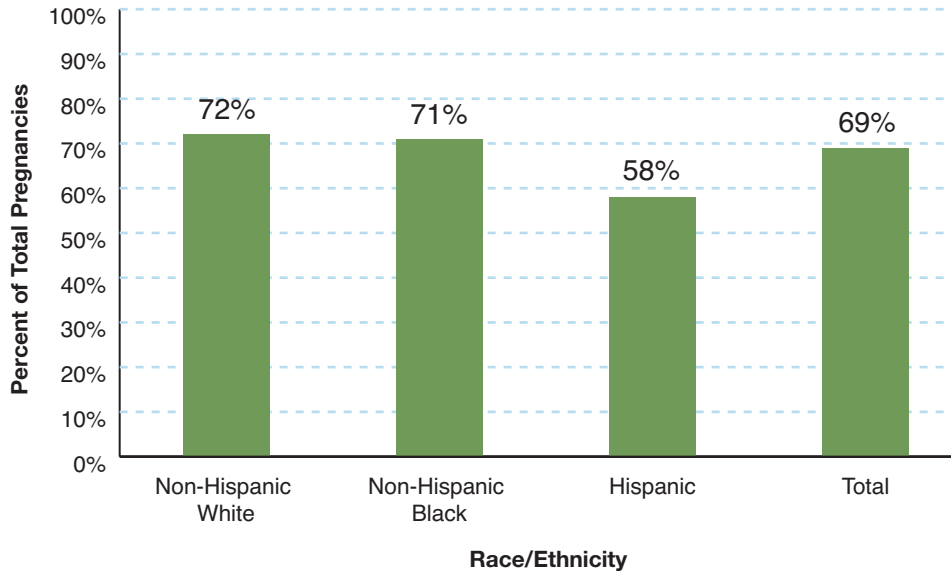


## B-5. Percent of Pregnancies that are Unplanned by Race/Ethnicity Among Unmarried Women Age 20–29, 2001<sup>8</sup>

- ▲ Seven out of ten pregnancies to unmarried 20-somethings are unplanned among non-Hispanic white and non-Hispanic black women.
- ▲ More than half of all pregnancies to unmarried Hispanic 20-somethings are unplanned (58%).
