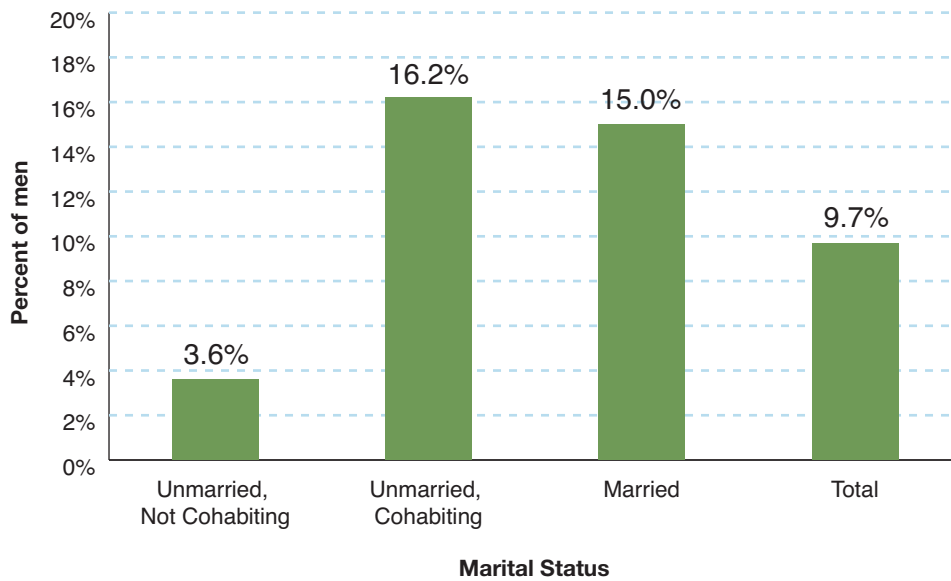


D-14. Percent of All Men Reporting an Unplanned Pregnancy Followed by a Birth, by Father's Marital Status, 2002

- ▲ The percent of men reporting an unplanned pregnancy followed by a birth is highest among men who are unmarried and cohabiting (16.2%).
- ▲ When multiplied by ten, these results approximate a rate of birth following unplanned pregnancy per 1,000 men; however the reader should be careful to note that such rates for men have not been officially tabulated.
