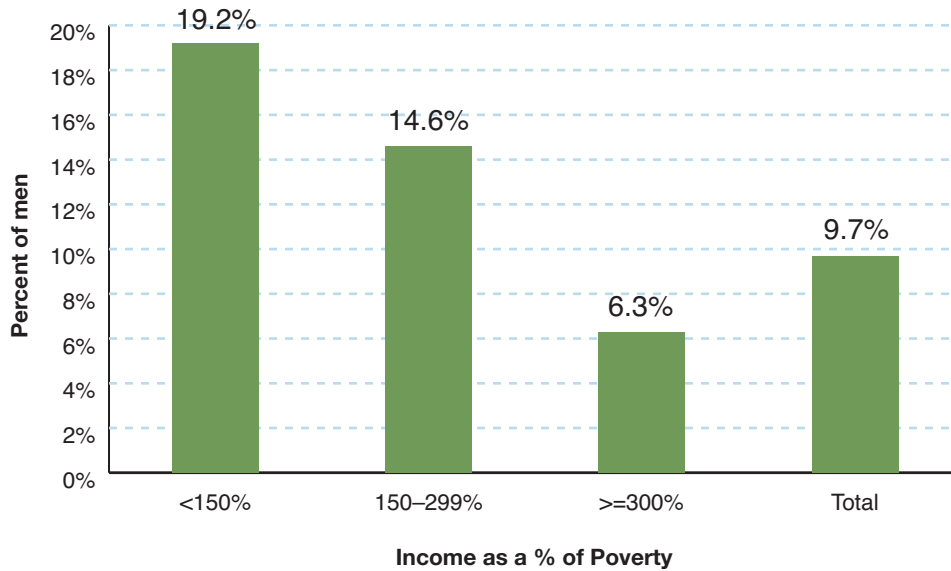


D-15. Percent of All Men Reporting an Unplanned Pregnancy Followed by a Birth, by Father's Income (as a % of Poverty), 2002

- ▲ The percent of men reporting an unplanned pregnancy followed by a birth is highest among men with incomes less than 150 percent of the federal poverty threshold.
- ▲ When multiplied by ten, these results approximate a rate birth of following unplanned pregnancy per 1,000 men; however the reader should be careful to note that such rates for men have not been officially tabulated.
